AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in construction and renovation of 5 buildings by school entities, further providing for maintenance program. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 2604-J(f) and (q) of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 11 12 are amended to read: 13 Section 2604-J. Maintenance program. * * * 14 15 (f) Limitation on grant award. --16 (1)No grant award for a maintenance project may exceed 17 [\$1,000,000] \$3,000,000. 18 No school entity may receive an annual allocation of 19 grants that exceeds 20% of the funds available under the 20 program.

- 3 program shall be funded from a set-aside equal to 25% of the
- 4 appropriation for school building projects annually under
- 5 this article.
- 6 (1.1) For fiscal years 2022-2023, 2023-2024 and 2024-
- 7 <u>2025, any amount appropriated for school building projects</u>
- 8 <u>shall be used exclusively for the program.</u>
- 9 [(2) No less than 20% of the funds allocated to the
- program under paragraph (1) shall be awarded to projects that
- enhance school building safety and security.]
- 12 (3) In any fiscal year when funds are available for
- grants under the program as provided in paragraph (1), the
- department shall allocate 50% of the set-aside for grants by
- December 31 and the other 50% of the set-aside for grants not
- 16 later than June 30 of that fiscal year.
