Consolidated Statutes, in Pennsylvania National Guard, 2 further providing for pay of officers and enlisted personnel 3 on special duty and for pay of officers and enlisted personnel in active State service; in Pennsylvania Guard, 5 further providing for pay and expenses of officers and enlisted personnel; and making editorial changes. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Sections 3101 and 3102(a) of Title 51 of the 11 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 12 § 3101. Pay of officers and enlisted personnel on special duty. 13 Members of the Pennsylvania National Guard or Pennsylvania 14 Guard may be ordered upon special duty at the discretion of the Governor and shall receive the pay and allowances of their 15 16 respective grades during the time they may continue upon duty 17 under such order. Notwithstanding any provisions of the current 18 Armed Forces Pay and Allowance Act, the pay of any such 19 personnel shall not be less than \$180 per day. As used in this section, the term "current Armed Forces Pay and Allowance Act" 20

- 2 <u>services</u>) or a successor statute.
- 3 § 3102. Pay of officers and enlisted personnel in active State
- 4 service.
- 5 (a) General rule. -- When the Pennsylvania National Guard or
- 6 Pennsylvania Guard, or any part thereof, is ordered on active
- 7 duty for State service by the Governor as Commander-in-Chief and
- 8 pay is authorized for such duty under the order prescribing the
- 9 performance thereof, the commissioned officers, warrant officers
- 10 and enlisted personnel so ordered shall be entitled to the same
- 11 pay and allowances and transportation in kind provided for in
- 12 the current Armed Forces Pay and Allowance Act. Notwithstanding
- 13 any provisions of such act, the pay of any such personnel shall
- 14 not be less than [\$100] \$180 per day. As used in this
- 15 <u>subsection</u>, the term "current Armed Forces Pay and Allowance
- 16 Act" means 37 U.S.C. (relating to pay and allowances of the
- 17 uniformed services) or a successor statute.

- 23 (d) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term "current
