## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled "An 1 act to promote the public health and safety by providing for 2 examination, licensing and granting of permits for those who 3 desire to engage in the profession of cosmetology; defining cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology salons, schools, 5 students, apprentices, teachers, managers, manicurists and cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties upon the 7 Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs of the 8 Department of State; providing for appeals to certain courts by applicants and licensees; and providing penalties," 10 providing for salon area and further providing for temporary 11 licenses. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred 16 to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended by adding a section to 17 read: 18 Section 9.4. Salon area. -- (a) The booth space of a licensed 19 cosmetology salon operated by one licensed cosmetologist must 20 have a minimum area of one hundred twenty square feet with a minimum width of ten feet. An additional area of at least sixty 21 square feet is required for each additional licensee in the 22

- 1 <u>salon. The board, upon a licensee's request, may grant a</u>
- 2 <u>variance from the booth space requirements concerning a licensed</u>
- 3 cosmetology salon which the board believes is reasonable.
- 4 (b) Salons opened prior to September 15, 1976, which have
- 5 been operating with one cosmetologist must have sufficient booth
- 6 space to properly install equipment with regard to the health
- 7 and safety of the patrons of the licensed cosmetology salon. The
- 8 booth space shall be a minimum of ten feet by twelve feet or one
- 9 <u>hundred twenty square feet with sixty square feet for each</u>
- 10 additional cosmetologist. The board, after examination of the
- 11 <u>salon's layout may grant a variance from the booth space</u>
- 12 <u>requirements which the board believes is reasonable.</u>
- 13 Section 2. Section 12.1 of the act is amended to read:
- 14 Section 12.1. Temporary Licenses. -- (a) Upon payment of the
- 15 required fee, a temporary license may be issued to any applicant
- 16 who is eliqible for admission to a cosmetologist's examination
- 17 or to the examination for any of the limited licenses. An
- 18 applicant who is thus licensed shall practice only under the
- 19 supervision of a licensed teacher or cosmetologist, or under the
- 20 supervision of the holder of a corresponding limited license,
- 21 until the time of the next scheduled examination. Temporary
- 22 licenses are granted for a nine-month period.
- 23 (b) Upon payment of a fee set by the board and not to exceed
- 24 one hundred dollars (\$100), a temporary license may be issued to
- 25 <u>a cosmetology salon that has submitted an application for an</u>
- 26 initial salon license. To be eligible for a temporary license, a
- 27 <u>cosmetology salon shall employ a licensed cosmetologist who has</u>
- 28 been practicing for at least three years and can only employ
- 29 themselves while operating under the temporary salon license. A
- 30 temporary salon license shall only be valid for ninety days.

1 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
