## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of April 2021 as "Pennsylvania 8-1-1 Safe Digging Month."
- WHEREAS, As engineers, designers, excavators and homeowners
- 4 work to keep pace with this Commonwealth's unprecedented
- 5 economic development, it is important to minimize damage to
- 6 underground utility lines, danger to workers, environmental
- 7 pollution and loss of utility service to residents of this
- 8 Commonwealth; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania One Call System, a utility
- 10 notification center celebrating more than 49 years of continuous
- 11 service to this Commonwealth, is key to preventing injuries and
- 12 damage when excavating and demolishing; and
- 13 WHEREAS, This unique service provides easy, one-call
- 14 notification about construction and excavation projects that may
- 15 endanger workers and jeopardize utility lines and promotes
- 16 workplace and public safety, reduces underground utility damage,
- 17 minimizes utility service interruptions and protects the
- 18 environment; and

- 1 WHEREAS, This vital service, which began with only six
- 2 utility companies in western Pennsylvania and the City of
- 3 Pittsburgh, now serves more than 100,000 excavators and 3,680
- 4 critical infrastructure owners throughout this Commonwealth; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In 2020, despite a worldwide pandemic, the
- 6 Pennsylvania One Call System received nearly 1 million
- 7 notification requests and transmitted more than 6.4 million
- 8 notifications to its members, providing protection to utility
- 9 companies, their employees and customers; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's Underground Utility Line Protection
- 11 Law, also known as the PA One Call Act, has been used as a model
- 12 for many other states and at least seven foreign countries; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Dozens of counties and hundreds of municipalities
- 14 are following in the footsteps of the Pennsylvania General
- 15 Assembly and adopting their own proclamations memorializing
- 16 "Safe Digging Month"; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of April 2021
- 18 as "Pennsylvania 8-1-1 Safe Digging Month" to encourage all
- 19 excavators and homeowners of this Commonwealth to dial 8-l-1 /
- 20 1-800-242-1776 or click www.pa811.org before planning a digging
- 21 project in order to "Know What's Below," avoid injury, protect
- 22 the environment and prevent millions of dollars in damages; and
- 23 be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the Senate remind excavators that three
- 25 business days' notice before digging is the law because safe
- 26 digging is no accident and that more information may be obtained
- 27 by visiting www.pa8ll.org; and be it further
- 28 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 29 the Governor, the Chairman of the Public Utility Commission, the
- 30 Secretary of Transportation, the Secretary of General Services,
