A RESOLUTION

1 2	Amending the Rules of the Senate, further providing for temporary emergency Rules of the Senate.
3	RESOLVED, That Rule 38 of the Rules of the Senate of
4	Pennsylvania be amended to read:
5	Rule 38. Temporary emergency Rules of the Senate.
6	(a) [continuity] <u>Continuity</u> of legislative operationsIn
7	order to maintain the continuity of the legislative operations
8	of the Senate and protect the health, safety and welfare of the
9	residents of the Commonwealth, based on the declaration of
10	disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, the
11	effect of which makes the convening of some or all of the
12	members of the Senate as a body in the Senate chamber of the
13	Capitol Building or at a single location imprudent, inexpedient
14	or impossible, the following apply:
15	(1) Notwithstanding Rules 6 and 7 the following apply:
16	(i) In the absence of the Secretary-Parliamentarian
17	and the Chief Clerk and subject to the direction of the
18	President Pro Tempore, the Assistant Secretary shall

attest all writs, warrants and subpoenas issued by order
 of the Senate and shall certify as to the passage of
 Senate bills and the approval of executive nominations.

4 (ii) In the absence of both officers and the
5 Assistant Secretary, the President Pro Tempore shall
6 designate a signatory.

7 (2) Notwithstanding Rule 9, there shall be no guest8 introductions.

9 (3) Notwithstanding Rule 14(h), members may remotely
10 participate in committee meetings as follows:

(i) A quorum shall be established through a rollcall.

(ii) Technology employed for remote committee meetings must safeguard the integrity of the legislative process and maintain the deliberative character of the meeting by providing for simultaneous aural and verbal communication among all participants.

18 (4) Notwithstanding Rule 14, the following apply:

(i) The President Pro Tempore may appoint a Senator
to serve in a temporary capacity as a member of a
committee, serving only for the duration of a single
session day for a particular committee meeting.

(ii) The President Pro Tempore shall transmit this
designation to the Secretary-Parliamentarian for
retention during the two-year legislative session, and
this record shall be available for public inspection upon
request.

(iii) The communication shall be read across the
desk and printed in the Senate Journal on the next
legislative day of the Senate.

1 (5) In addition to the provisions of Rule 14, the 2 following apply: 3 (i) Regulations [shall] may be deposited with the Legislative Reference Bureau. 4 5 (ii) The bureau shall transmit the regulations to the appropriate committee for consideration within 24 6 7 hours. The bureau shall transmit notice of the 8 (iii) transmission of the regulations to the Secretary-9 10 Parliamentarian. (iv) The time for consideration shall begin on the 11 12 date the committee receives the regulations from the 13 bureau. 14 In addition to the provisions of Rule 17, the (6) 15 following apply: 16 Members participating remotely may cast votes (i) for all measures considered and brought to a vote by the 17 18 committee, as if the members were physically present at 19 the committee meeting. 20 The identity of the voting member must be (ii) 21 verified by the Chair. 22 A member may also vote on matters before the (iii) committee pursuant to Rule 16(3). 23 24 Notwithstanding Rule 20, members may remotely (7) 25 participate in the session of the Senate as follows: 26 Members participating remotely may cast votes (i) 27 for all measures considered and brought to a vote during 28 session, as if the members were physically present at the 29 session of the Senate. 30 The identity of the voting member must be (ii) 20210SR0090PN0615 - 3 -

verified by the presiding officer.

2 (iii) Technology employed for remote participation 3 in Senate session must safequard the integrity of the legislative process and maintain the deliberative 4 5 character of the session by providing for simultaneous aural and verbal communication among all participants. 6 7 (iv) A member may also vote as provided in Rule 8 20(b)(1) and (2). Notwithstanding Rule 23, the Chief Clerk may provide 9 (8) 10 for remote participation technology that enables members to 11 participate in committee meetings and Senate session. 12 (9) Notwithstanding Rule 27, the following apply: 13 (i) Senators participating remotely in the session 14 of the Senate shall be counted for the purpose of 15 determining a quorum. 16 (ii) A quorum shall be established through a roll 17 call if the identity of the voting member is identified 18 by the presiding officer. 19 This rule shall expire [march 31, 2021] May 31, (10)20 2021, or 10 days following the expiration of the emergency 21 declaration, whichever is earlier, unless otherwise further 22 extended in accordance with the Rules of the Senate. Definitions.--As used in this Rule, the following words 23 (b) 24 and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 25 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 26 "Remote participation." Simultaneous, interactive participation in a committee meeting by committee members not 27 28 physically present at the location of the meeting, through means 29 of communication technologies designed to accommodate and facilitate such simultaneous, interactive participation. 30
