## A RESOLUTION

Supporting an amendment to the Constitution of the United States 1 to establish that election spending may be regulated to 2 ensure that every resident may exercise the rights to free 3 speech, political participation and meaningful 5 representation, and to protect republican self-government and ◀ federalism. 6 7 WHEREAS, We the People have a compelling interest in 8 fostering robust political debate and self-government, securing the liberty and political equality of our residents, guarding 10 against corruption and advancing federalism and the interests of 11 the several states; and 12 WHEREAS, Over the past few decades, the Supreme Court has gradually come to equate election spending with "free speech"; 13 14 and WHEREAS, This spending has the potential to drown out speech 15 16 rights for all residents, narrow debate, weaken federalism and 17 self-governance in the states and increase the risk of systemic 18 corruption; and 19 WHEREAS, The states and Congress should have the ability to

- 1 enact reasonable regulations regarding this spending; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The framers wisely granted the states ultimate power
- 3 to amend our Constitution where necessary to make it and our
- 4 union ever more perfect and to protect and preserve self-
- 5 government and liberty; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 support an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to
- 8 establish that election spending may be regulated to ensure that
- 9 every resident may exercise the rights to free speech, political
- 10 participation and meaningful representation, and to protect
- 11 republican self-government and federalism; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the people of Pennsylvania hereby call upon
- 13 the United States Congress to propose and send to the states for
- 14 ratification a Constitutional amendment to clarify that states
- 15 may regulate the spending of money to influence elections in the
- 16 states and that Congress may regulate the spending of money to
- 17 influence Federal elections, and that in doing so the states and
- 18 Congress may distinguish between natural persons and legally
- 19 recognized entities; and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be prepared and
- 21 submitted to the Majority Leader of the United States Senate,
- 22 the Minority Leader of the United States Senate, the Speaker of
- 23 the United States House of Representatives, the Minority Leader
- 24 of the United States House of Representatives and to each member
- 25 of Congress from Pennsylvania.
