## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and 2 related offenses, providing for the offense of transporting 3 dogs in external section of vehicle; and imposing penalties. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 5538.1. Transporting dogs in external section of vehicle. 10 (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be prohibited to carry or cause or allow to be carried a dog on the hood, roof, truck bed 11 or any other external section of a vehicle on a public road in 12 this Commonwealth. 13 14 (b) Grading. -- Upon conviction, a violation under this 15 section shall be a summary offense punishable by: 16 (1) A fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$150 for a first violation. 17

(2) A fine of not less than \$150 nor more than \$300 for

- 1 <u>a second violation.</u>
- 2 (3) A fine of not less than \$300 nor more than \$500 or
- 3 imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both, for a third
- 4 <u>or subsequent violation.</u>
- 5 (c) Exception. -- This section shall not apply to a dog
- 6 transported in a secured insulated cage or container which is
- 7 designed to facilitate the safe transportation of a dog and will
- 8 prevent the dog from being exposed to outside weather conditions
- 9 and from falling, jumping or being thrown from the vehicle.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
