Aggravated assault. 8 * * * 9 (c) Officers, employees, etc., enumerated. -- The officers, 10 11 agents, employees and other persons referred to in subsection (a) shall be as follows: 12 * * * 1.3 14 (27) A teaching staff member, a school board member or 15 other employee, including a student employee, of any 16 elementary or secondary publicly funded educational institution, any elementary or secondary private school 17 18 licensed by the Department of Education or any elementary or

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
