## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
- "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
- 3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
- thereto," in township engineer, further providing for
- township engineer and providing for waiver.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1301 of the act of June 24, 1931
- 9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code, is
- 10 amended to read:
- 11 Section 1301. Township Engineer.--
- 12 (a) [The] Subject to section 1301.1, the board of
- 13 commissioners [may appoint and determine the compensation of a
- 14 township engineer who must be a registered professional
- 15 engineer] shall appoint, through a competitive bid process, and
- 16 <u>determine the compensation of at least two township engineers</u>.
- 17 The township [engineer serves] engineers serve at the pleasure
- 18 of the board of commissioners.
- 19 (b) As used in this article, the term "engineer" means one

- 1 or more registered professional engineers or a firm of
- 2 registered professional engineers.
- 3 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 4 <u>Section 1301.1. Waiver.--(a) If the board of commissioners</u>
- 5 <u>cannot obtain offers from qualified registered civil engineers</u>
- 6 to fulfill the requirement under section 1301 to appoint at
- 7 <u>least two township engineers, the board of commissioners may be</u>
- 8 relieved from the requirement by completing a certification
- 9 form, subject to the following:
- 10 <u>(1) The board of commissioners must complete the</u>
- 11 <u>certification form before the contract with the selected</u>
- 12 township engineer is executed and must maintain the form
- 13 throughout the life of the contract with the township engineer.
- 14 (2) The certification form must be completed annually.
- 15 (3) A copy of the certification form must be filed with the
- 16 department.
- 17 (4) The department shall furnish the certification form,
- 18 which must:
- 19 <u>(i) Require the board of commissioners to disclose the</u>
- 20 methods and dates of the public solicitation. For purposes of
- 21 meeting this requirement, the board of commissioners shall
- 22 <u>advertise requests for proposals and announce the solicitation</u>
- 23 at a public meeting.
- 24 (ii) Require the board of commissioners to disclose the
- 25 number of qualified bids received in response to the public
- 26 <u>solicitation</u>.
- 27 (iii) Contain a statement that the information provided by
- 28 the board of commissioners is in compliance with 18 Pa.C.S. §
- 29 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).
- 30 (iv) Contain a statement that the department does not have

- 1 the discretion to deny waiver requests.
- 2 (b) As used in this section, the term "department" means the
- 3 <u>Department of Labor and Industry of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
