8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
12	section to read:
13	Section 1368. Evaluation of Potentially Hazardous Walking
14	Routes(a) The department shall develop a form for members of
15	the public, including students and parents and guardians of
16	students, to request that a school district contact the
17	department to evaluate potentially hazardous walking routes for
18	students on their way to and from a school in the school
19	district. The following apply:
20	(1) The form shall be:

1	(i) Provided by the department and the school district in
2	hard copy form upon request.
3	(ii) Posted on the publicly accessible Internet website of
4	the department and the school district.
5	(2) The form shall:
6	(i) Require the name, address, telephone number and other
7	contact information of the requestor completing the form.
8	(ii) Contain space for a full description of the potentially
9	hazardous walking route.
10	(iii) Allow for the submittal of any available photographs
11	of the potentially hazardous walking route.
12	(b) A school district that receives a completed form under
13	subsection (a) shall notify the requestor regarding whether the
14	school district has determined that the department should be
15	contacted to evaluate the potentially hazardous walking route.
16	If the school district determines that the department should not
17	be so contacted, the school district shall inform the requestor
18	of the reason for that determination.
19	(c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
20	shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
21	the context clearly indicates otherwise:
22	"Department." The Department of Transportation of the
23	Commonwealth.
24	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
