AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," in charter schools, providing for
6 invoices for special education services.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
11 section to read:

12 Section 1725.1-A. Invoices for Special Education Services.--

13 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law:

14 (1) During the 2023-2024 school year and each school year
15 thereafter, each charter school, regional charter school and
16 cyber charter school that provides special education services
17 for a student and that seeks payments for the special education
18 services shall provide to the school district of residence of
19 the student an invoice, or periodic invoices, specifying the

1 special education services actually provided to the student and
2 the cost of providing the special education services to the
3 student, along with any documentation required by the school
4 district of residence.

5 (2) Payments for special education services under this
6 section shall be made to the charter school, regional charter
7 school and cyber charter school only after submittal of the
8 invoice, or periodic invoices, and review of the information
9 provided.

10 (3) The amount of the payments for special education
11 services under this section shall be in lieu of any rate or
12 calculation specified under this chapter or any other provision
13 of law.

14 (b) The department shall develop a form for the invoice
15 described in subsection (a). The form shall be posted on the
16 publicly accessible Internet website of the department.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
