AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 23, 1978 (P.L.537, No.93), entitled "An
2 act establishing minimum wages and providing for hours of
3 labor of seasonal farm workers and requiring certain records;
4 providing for inspection of seasonal farm labor camps;
5 providing for the promulgation of rules and regulations;
6 establishing rights of access and egress, providing
7 penalties; and repealing certain acts," in wages and hours,
8 further providing for hours of labor.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Section 207(a) and (b) of the act of June 23,
12 1978 (P.L.537, No.93), known as the Seasonal Farm Labor Act, are
13 amended to read:

14 Section 207. Hours of labor.

15 (a) No seasonal farm worker shall be required to work or be
16 penalized for failure to work on any premises for more than six
17 days in any one week, or more than [48] 60 hours in any one
18 week, or more than [ten] 12 hours in any one day.

19 (b) Whenever any seasonal farm workers shall be employed or
20 permitted to work on the premises of more than one employer in
21 any one week or in any one day, the aggregate number of hours

1 during which he shall be required to work on all such premises
2 shall not exceed [48] 60 in any one week or [ten] 12 in any one
3 day.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
