 section 2719(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

- 16 <u>"Federal judicial officer." The following:</u>
- 17 (1) An active or senior judge of the United States Court
- 18 of Appeals for the Third Circuit who is a resident of this
- 19 <u>Commonwealth.</u>

- 1 (2) An active or senior judge of a Federal district
- 2 court for the Eastern, Middle or Western District of
- 3 Pennsylvania.
- 4 (3) An active, retired or senior bankruptcy judge or tax
- 5 <u>court judge of the United States Bankruptcy Courts or United</u>
- 6 States Tax Courts for the Eastern, Middle or Western District
- 7 <u>of Pennsylvania.</u>
- 8 (4) An active or senior judge or full-time magistrate of
- 9 <u>the District Courts of the United States for the Eastern,</u>
- 10 Middle or Western District of Pennsylvania.
- "Public safety official." An individual listed under section
- 12 2702(c) (relating to aggravated assault), including a Federal_
- 13 judicial officer.
