AN ACT

Amending the act of May 28, 1937 (P.L.955, No.265), entitled "An act to promote public health, safety, morals, and welfare by 1 2 declaring the necessity of creating public bodies, corporate 3 and politic, to be known as housing authorities to engage in slum clearance, and to undertake projects, to provide 5 dwelling accommodations for persons of low income; providing for the organization of such housing authorities; defining 7 their powers and duties; providing for the exercise of such 8 9 powers, including the acquisition of property by purchase, gift or eminent domain, the renting and selling of property, 10 and including borrowing money, issuing bonds, and other 11 obligations, and giving security therefor; prescribing the 12 remedies of obligees of housing authorities; authorizing 13 housing authorities to enter into agreements, including 14 agreements with the United States, the Commonwealth, and 15 political subdivisions and municipalities thereof; defining 16 the application of zoning, sanitary, and building laws and 17 regulations to projects built or maintained by such housing 18 19 authorities; exempting the property and securities of such housing authorities from taxation; and imposing duties and 20 conferring powers upon the State Planning Board, and certain 21 other State officers and departments," further providing for 22 23 powers of authority.

- 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 hereby enacts as follows:
- 26 Section 1. Section 10(ee) of the act of May 28, 1937
- 27 (P.L.955, No.265), referred to as the Housing Authorities Law,
- 28 is amended to read:

- 1 Section 10. Powers of an Authority. -- An Authority shall
- 2 constitute a public body, corporate and politic, exercising
- 3 public powers of the Commonwealth as an agency thereof, which
- 4 powers shall include all powers necessary or appropriate to
- 5 carry out and effectuate the purpose and provisions of this act,
- 6 including the following powers, in addition to others herein
- 7 granted:
- 8 * * *
- 9 (ee) In a county of the second class [and], city of the
- 10 second class and city of the third class, to appoint police
- 11 officers who shall exercise the same powers that may be
- 12 exercised under authority of law or ordinance by the police of
- 13 the municipalities wherein the Authority is located, including,
- 14 but not limited to, those powers conferred pursuant to 42
- 15 Pa.C.S. Ch. 89 Subch. D (relating to municipal police
- 16 jurisdiction) with respect to the property and enforcing order
- 17 on and adjacent to the grounds and buildings of the Authority:
- 18 Provided, That said police officers complete the same course of
- 19 instruction as is required for municipal police officers by 53
- 20 Pa.C.S. Ch. 21 Subch. D (relating to municipal police education
- 21 and training) and receive certification by the Municipal Police
- 22 Officers' Education and Training Commission as having completed
- 23 the instruction. Said police officers shall maintain the
- 24 certification as a condition of employment as police officers
- 25 for the Authority.

- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
