AN ACT

Designating a portion of state Route 2008 from the intersection with State Route 2009 to the intersection with Pennsylvania Route 56 in West Wheatfield Township and East Wheatfield Township, Indiana County, as the Robindale Memorial Highway. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Robindale Memorial Highway.
(a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
(1) The town of Robindale stands as a testament to the indomitable spirit and resilience of its residents, having overcome numerous challenges throughout its storied history.
(2) The heart of this community was deeply impacted by two tragic mining accidents that claimed the lives of 11 dedicated coal miners who toiled tirelessly to support their town.
(3) In addition to this profound loss, Robindale has valiantly endured three severe floods that tested the mettle of its residents, demonstrating their unwavering commitment
to preserving their beloved community.
(4) It is fitting and just to recognize the sacrifices of these 11 brave miners and the resiliency of the entire Robindale community.
(b) Designation.--The portion of State Route 2008 from the intersection with State Route 2009 to the intersection with Pennsylvania Route 56 in West Wheatfield Township and East Wheatfield Township, Indiana County, is designated as the Robindale Memorial Highway.
(c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the designated highway to traffic in both directions.

Section 2. Effective date.
This act shall take effect in 60 days.
