AN ACT

Amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), entitled "An act establishing a uniform construction code; imposing 2 powers and duties on municipalities and the Department of 3 Labor and Industry; providing for enforcement; imposing penalties; and making repeals," in preliminary provisions, 4 5 further providing for Uniform Construction Code Review and 6 Advisory Council. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 9 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 107(m)(1) of the act of November 10, 1999 11 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code 12 Act, is amended by adding a subparagraph to read: 13 Section 107. Uniform Construction Code Review and Advisory Council. 14 15 16 Technical advisory committees. --17 The council shall establish a process by which technical advisory committees will assist the council in the 18 review of the updated sections. The technical advisory 19

1	committee process shall comply with the following
2	requirements:

4	(i.1) There shall be a technical advisory committee
5	for the purpose of recommending modifications and
6	limitations to the International Building Code that would
7	allow for a single-exit stairway to serve multifamily
8	residential structures up to six stories above grade
9	plane. The following apply:
10	(A) The recommendations must include
11	considerations for adequate and available water
12	supply, the presence and response time of a fire
13	department and any other provisions necessary to
14	ensure the health, safety and general welfare of the
15	public.
16	(B) The technical advisory committee shall
17	provide its recommendations to the council in time
18	for the adoption or amendment of rules or codes
19	implementing the next version of the International
20	Building Code that is scheduled to be adopted.
