- 3 WHEREAS, Former State Representative Harry Bowser passed away
- 4 on February 22, 2024, at 92 years of age at Parkside North East;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Bowser was born September 13, 1931, in
- 7 Coolspring; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Immediately after high school Mr. Bowser joined the
- 9 United States Marine Corps, which affiliation he honored and
- 10 carried proudly throughout the remainder of his life; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Upon discharge from the Marines in 1952, Mr. Bowser
- 12 opened a barbering business in North East and became a leader in
- 13 the community; and
- 14 WHEREAS, In 1955, Mr. Bowser married the love of his life and
- 15 partner, Carol, and had three sons, Timothy, Dennis and Andrew;

- 17 WHEREAS, In 1972, the Bowsers bought a 65-acre grape farm,
- 18 transforming an antiquated operation into a modernized and

- 2 WHEREAS, At the behest of community members, Mr. Bowser ran
- 3 for and won a seat in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives
- 4 in 1978 where he served for 10 years; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Upon retirement, the Bowsers embarked on many
- 6 adventures worldwide; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Bowser is survived by his sons Timothy Bowser,
- 8 Dennis and his wife Carmen Bowser, Andrew Bowser, his grandsons
- 9 Sherard and Lamar Bowser and his companion, Josephine Ganzer;
