## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 17, 2016 (P.L.84, No.16), entitled "An act establishing a medical marijuana program; providing for 2 patient and caregiver certification and for medical marijuana 3 organization registration; imposing duties on the Department 4 of Health; providing for a tax on medical marijuana 5 organization gross receipts; establishing the Medical 6 7 Marijuana Program Fund; establishing the Medical Marijuana Advisory Board; establishing a medical marijuana research 8 program; imposing duties on the Department of Corrections, 9 the Department of Education and the Department of Human 10 Services; and providing for academic clinical research 11 centers and for penalties and enforcement," in preliminary 12 provisions, further providing for definitions; and, in 13 program, further providing for lawful use of medical 14 marijuana and for unlawful use of medical marijuana. 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Section 1. Section 103 of the act of April 17, 2016 (P.L.84, No.16), known as the Medical Marijuana Act, is amended by adding 19 a definition to read: 20 21 Section 103. Definitions. 22 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 23 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 13 Section 2. Section 303(b)(2) of the act is amended and the

- 17 (b) Requirements.--The lawful use of medical marijuana is
- 18 subject to the following:

- 20 (2) Subject to regulations promulgated under this act,
- 21 medical marijuana may only be dispensed to a patient or
- 22 caregiver in the following forms:
- 23 (i) pill;
- 24 (ii) oil;
- 25 (iii) topical forms, including gels, creams or

- 27 (iv) a form medically appropriate for administration
- by vaporization or nebulization, excluding dry leaf or
- 29 plant form until dry leaf or plant forms become
- 30 acceptable under regulations adopted under section 1202;

- 5 (c) Edible medical marijuana products. -- The department shall
- 6 promulgate regulations governing eligible medical marijuana

- 9 products to ensure the safety of patients and minors. The
- 10 department may require a grower/processor to comply with
