Section 5705 of Title 3 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: [(Reserved).] Food allergy awareness program. 8 \$ 5705. (a) Establishment. -- The Department of Health shall establish 9 a food allergy awareness program. The food allergy awareness 10 program shall require a public eating or drinking place to 11 comply with all of the following: 12 (1) Designate a manager who is knowledgeable regarding 1.3 14 issues concerning food allergies and food preparation. 15 (2) Require each food employee to review the materials provided under subsection (b) on food allergy issues. 16 17 (b) Materials. -- The Department of Health shall prepare and

provide written and video materials on food allergy issues to a

- 2 <u>as required under subsection (a)(2).</u>
- 3 (c) Licensure requirements.--Each licensor, in collaboration
- 4 with the Department of Health, shall require a minimum knowledge
- 5 of food allergy issues as a condition for licensure under
- 6 <u>section 5703 (relating to license required).</u>
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
