An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - **Children & Youth, March 12, 2019** **3**

This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

(Representatives ROAE, TURZAI, AND DELOZIER) – **Consumer Affairs, March 18, 2019** **1**

This bill amends Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in powers and duties, further providing for power of commission to order acquisition of small water and sewer utilities; in procedure on complaints, further providing for service of complaints on parties; and, in rates and distribution systems, further providing for computation of income tax expense for ratemaking purposes.

(Representatives STAATS, KAUFFMAN, JAMES and others) – **Education, March 18, 2019** **1**

This bill expands the online database of articulation agreements for Career and Technical Education (CTE).

270 An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in preliminary provisions, providing for career information and recruitment. (Representatives MAKO, BERNSTINE, DUNBAR and others) – **Education, March 18, 2019** **1**

This bill provides for educational or career opportunities and employment training for Career and Technical Education (CTE) for students grade 4 through 12.

(Representatives GROVE, KAUFFMAN, RYAN and others) - **Education, March 18, 2019** **1**

This bill commissions for agricultural education excellence, in vocational education, providing for utilization of credits and providing for classification for Career and Technical Education (CTE).

744 An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in vocational education, providing for an online career resource center. (Representatives HARKINS, ROEBUCK, KINSEY and others) - **Education, March 18, 2019** **1**

This bill creates an online career resource center for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs.

859 An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in vocational education, providing for a workforce development program clearinghouse. (Representatives MULLERY, MURT, HILL-EVANS and others) - **Education, March 18, 2019** **1**

This bill requires PDE to inventory workforce development programs offered at secondary and postsecondary institutions for Career and Technical Education (CTE).

861 An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, providing for the Career and Technical Education Investment Incentive Program. (Representatives TOBASH, B. MILLER, SCHLOSSBERG and others) - **Education, March 18, 2019** **1**

This bill creates a Career and Technical Education (CTE) investment incentive program; including tax credits for contributions to support CTE programs and enrollment expansion programs.

398 An Act amending the act of July 8, 1978 (P.L.752, No.140), known as the **Public Employee Pension Forfeiture Act**, further providing for definitions, for disqualification and forfeiture of benefits and for restitution for monetary loss; and repealing a retroactivity provision. (Senators DiSANTO, BROWNE, MENSCH and others) - **Judiciary, March 18, 2019** **1**

This bill amends the Public Employee Pension Forfeiture Act to add any offense graded as a felony or punishable by more than 5 years of imprisonment; and to provide that pension benefits are forfeited when a plea of guilty or no contest is entered, or when a finding of guilt occurs.

347 An Act amending Titles 27 (Environmental Resources) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for **Keystone Tree Fund**; and, in registration of vehicles, providing for contributions to the **Keystone Tree Fund**. (Representatives EVERETT, SOLOMON, PASHINSKI and others) - **Transportation, February 21, 2019** **5**

This bill amends Title 27 & 75 to provide for Keystone Tree Fund.
