SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

881

HOUSE

An Act amending the act of June 18, 1982 (P.L.549, No.159), entitled "An act providing for the administration of certain 1434 Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program. (Representatives FEE, RYAN, BERNSTINE others) - Agriculture & Rural Affairs, June 28, 2019

This bill provides for the administration of certain Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS

HOUSE 309

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - Children & Youth, June 12, 2019 13

This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS

HOUSE 1633

An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further providing for employees having contact with children; adoptive and foster parents. (Representative BOBACK) - Rules, June 24, 2019

This bill amends the Child Protective Services Law to provide for additional background check requirements and to restrict provisional employment arrangements.

SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILL

HOUSE 247

999

An Act amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for well permits. (Representatives OBERLANDER, FRITZ, JAMES and others) – Environmental Resources & Energy, June 24, 2019

This bill amends Title 58 to provide for cross unit drilling.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HUMAN SERVICES BILL

HOUSE 1662 2207

An Act amending the act of October 24, 2012 (P.L.1198, No.148), known as the Methadone Death and Incident Review Act, further providing for title of act, for short title, for definitions, for establishment of Methadone Death and Incident Review Team, for team duties, for duties of coroner and medical examiner, for review procedures and for confidentiality. (Representatives DiGIROLAMO, KINSEY, ZABEL and others) – Rules, September 19, 2019

This bill add buprenorphine to the Methadone Death and Incident Review.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 111 1630

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives SCHEMEL, McCLINTON, SIMS and others) – Judiciary, June 18, 2019

This bill is a Joint Resolution amending Article V of the PA Constitution to provide for the appointment of justices to the Supreme Court and judges to the Superior and Commonwealth Courts and establishing the Appellate Court Nominating Commission.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE 785

An Act amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, further providing for definitions; in employee rights, providing for payments to employee organizations; and making related repeals. (Representatives KLUNK, RYAN, MOUL and others) – Labor & Industry, June 20, 2019 9

This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILLS

HOUSE 1074

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, providing for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class. (Representatives TURZAI, HENNESSEY, RYAN and others) – Local Government, June 17, 2019

This bill provides for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class.

HOUSE **1246**

An Act amending the act of July 10, 1987 (P.L.246, No.47), known as the Municipalities Financial Recovery Act, in municipal financial distress, further providing for designation and for performance of coordinator; and, in receivership in municipalities, further providing for receiver. (Representatives FREEMAN, JAMES, MOUL and others) – Local Government, September 19, 2019

This bill provides for designation and for performance of coordinator and in receivership in municipalities.

SECOND CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILLS

HOUSE 1069 2209

An Act amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in open meetings, further providing for public notice and providing for notification of agency business required and exceptions. (Representatives BERNSTINE AND SIMMONS) - Rules, September 18, 2019

This bill amends the Sunshine Act to require a public agency to post public meeting agendas on the Internet no later than 24 hours prior to a meeting, and to prohibit an agency from taking official action on items not in the meeting agenda.

SECOND CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILLS

HOUSE 1316

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, 1535 providing for spending limitations on the Commonwealth. (Representatives WARNER AND HERSHEY) - Rules, September 19, 2019

This bill amends the Constitution to establish limitations on the spending of Commonwealth funds.

SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 2058 Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, and are providing for learners' definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for learners' permits; in rules of the road in general, repealing provisions relating to prohibiting text-based communications, prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices, imposing penalties and establishing the Distracted Driver Awareness Fund; and, in operation of vehicles miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the offense of homicide by vehicle and for the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle. (Representatives BROWN, READSHAW, STEPHENS and others) - Rules, September 19, 2019

This bill prohibits the use of hand-held interactive wireless communication devices while operating a motor vehicle.

HOUSE 1392

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in liquid fuels and fuels tax, further providing 2060 for definitions and providing for electric vehicle road use fee; and making editorial changes. (Representatives CARROLL, NEILSON, READSHAW and others) - Rules, September 19, 2019

This bill establishes the Electric Vehicle Road Fee.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 1037 1830

An Act amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions and for application; and, in exemptions, applicability and penalties, further providing for penalties. (Representatives LAWRENCE, CAUSER, BERNSTINE and others) - Appropriations, June 26, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to exempt historic agricultural buildings, when used for private events and meeting certain safety provisions, from the provisions of the code.

THIRD CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILL

HOUSE 1410 2161

An Act amending the act of December 8, 2004 (P.L.1801, No.238), known as the Transit Revitalization Investment District Act, in general provisions, further providing for declaration of policy and for definitions; providing for military installation remediation; and establishing the Military Installation Remediation Fund. (Representatives STEPHENS, KENYATTA, ULLMAN and others) - Appropriations, June 18, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

This bill provides for military installation remediation and establishes the Military Installation Remediation Fund.

THIRD CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILL

HOUSE 1283 1854

An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in judgments and other liens, further providing for exemption of particular property. (Representatives MOUL, PICKETT, RYAN and others) - Appropriations, September 17, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

This bill amends Title 40 and Title 42 to provide consumer protections for annuity benefit plans.

THIRD CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

196

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organizing the Judiciary into representative districts and further providing for residency requirements. (Representatives DIAMOND, BERNSTINE, CAUSER and others) – Appropriations, June 24, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

This bill proposes integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organizing the Judiciary into representative districts and further providing for residency requirements.
