An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school districts, further providing for how constituted. (Representatives MUSTELLO, STRUZZI, ROWE and others) - **Education, March 17, 2021 14**

This bill amends the Public School Code to permit a school district to change its name.

An Act relating to conventional wells and the development of oil, gas and coal; imposing powers and duties on the Department of Environmental Protection; and providing for preliminary provisions, for general requirements, for underground gas storage, for enforcement and remedies, for related funds, parties and activities and for miscellaneous provisions. (Representatives CAUSER, RAPP, METCALFE and others) - **Environmental Resources & Energy, May 24, 2021 1**

This bill establishes the Conventional Oil and Gas Wells Act.

331 An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as **The Fiscal Code, in emergency finance and tax provisions, providing for exemption from taxation.** (Representatives MARKOSEK, HILL-EVANS, A. DAVIS and others) - **Finance, May 4, 2021** **3**

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to exclude economic recovery payments issued under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from consideration as income, earned income or taxable income.

357 An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as **the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income.** (Representatives DUNBAR, ROTHMAN, BROOKS and others) - **Finance, May 4, 2021** **3**

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to exclude an amount of loan forgiveness granted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from state income tax.

195 An Act amending **Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of unlawful contact with minor.** (Representatives MUSTELLO, KAUFFMAN, BOBACK and others) - **Judiciary, May 24, 2021** **1**

This bill amends Section 6318 of the Crimes Code to add certain prohibited activities that, if committed, constitute the crime of unlawful contact with a minor.

214 An Act amending **Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in human trafficking, further providing for evidence and defenses to human trafficking.** (Representatives MIHALEK, THOMAS, PICKETT and others) - **Judiciary, May 24, 2021** **1**

This bill amends Section 3018 of Title 18 to apply the protections contained within Pennsylvania's Rape Shield Law to victims of human trafficking.

543 An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in depositions and witnesses, further providing for expert testimony in certain criminal proceedings. (Representatives SCHROEDER, BROOKS, GLEIM and others) - **Judiciary, May 24, 2021** **1**

This bill amends Section 5920 of Title 42 to expand the list of offenses whereby an expert may testify in sexual and domestic assault cases.

741 An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against the family, further providing for the offense of dealing in infant children. (Representatives JOZWIAK, SCHMITT, SCHLEGEL CULVER and others) - **Judiciary, May 24, 2021** **1**

This bill amends Section 4305 of Title 18 to increase the grading for a conviction for dealing in infant children from a misdemeanor of the first degree to a felony of the first degree.

827 An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child custody, further providing for consideration of criminal conviction. (Representatives ROWE, BURGOS, CIRESI and others) - **Judiciary, May 24, 2021** **1**

This bill amends Section 5329 of Title 23 to expand the list of criminal convictions of a party or member of a party's household that a court must consider before making a custody determination.

1128 An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in human trafficking, further providing for civil causes of action. (Representatives KAUFFMAN, N. NELSON, RYAN and others) - **Judiciary, May 24, 2021** **1**

This bill amends Section 3051 of Title 18 to alter the venue for a statutory civil action available to a victim of the sex trade.

This bill amends Title 42 to provide for sexual offenses and tier system.

This bill amends the Unemployment Compensation Law to require the Department of Labor & Industry reinstate the work search and CareerLink registration requirements for unemployment compensation claimants.

This bill makes permanent the sale of prepared beverages and mixed drinks.

This bill bans the use of handheld cellphones while driving.

This bill designates the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.

117 An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43267, on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge. This bill designates a bridge on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.

This bill requires planting of native vegetation along state highways.

This bill designates a bridge carrying State Route 2027 in North Union Township, Fayette County, as the SSG Willis J. Crayton Memorial Bridge.

This bill designates a roundabout at Pennsylvania Route 34, Spring Road, Pennsylvania Route 850, Valley Road, and Pisgah State Road in Carroll Township, Perry County, as the Shane E. Troutman Memorial Roundabout.

228 An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8556, carrying SR 1008 (Eckenrode Mill Road) over Chest Creek, located in East Carroll Township, Cambria County, as the Kenneth John Ivory Memorial Bridge. (Senator LANGERHOLC) - **Transportation, April 19, 2021** **7**

This bill designates a bridge in Cambria County as the Kenneth John Ivory Memorial Bridge.

229 An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for contributions to Veterans' Trust Fund. (Senators ROBINSON, MARTIN, BARTOLOTTA and others) - **Transportation, April 5, 2021** **10**

This bill increases contribution amounts to the Veterans Trust Fund.
