An Act amending the act of December 20, 1982 (P.L.1404, No.325), known as the Self-Service Storage Facility Act, further providing for owner's lien, for enforcement of lien, for notice, for advertisement of sale and for location of sale. (Representatives GILLESPIE, MOUL, JONES and others) - Commerce, June 16, 2021 **1**

This bill amends the Self- Storage Facility Act to clarify newspaper advertising and late fees.

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school districts, further providing for how constituted. (Representatives MUSTELLO, STRUZZI, ROWE and others) - Education, May 26, 2021 **8**

This bill amends the Public School Code to permit a school district to change its name.

815 An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in pupils and attendance, providing for extended special education enrollment due to COVID-19; and, in terms and courses of study, providing for optional year of education due to COVID-19. (Senators CORMAN, MARTIN, BAKER and others) - **Education, June 09, 2021** 5

This bill amends the Public School Code to permit an optional additional year of education at a school entity for the 2021-2022 school year due to COVID-19.

331 An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, in emergency finance and tax provisions, providing for exemption from taxation. (Representatives MARKOSEK, HILL-EVANS, A. DAVIS and others) - **Finance, May 4, 2021** 12

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to exclude economic recovery payments issued under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from consideration as income, earned income or taxable income.

357 An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives DUNBAR, ROTHMAN, BROOKS and others) - **Finance, May 4, 2021** 12

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to exclude an amount of loan forgiveness granted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from state income tax.

This bill amends Title 35 by adding two new chapters on Vaccinations and the Disease Prevention and Control.

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, repealing provisions relating to firearms not to be carried without a license, providing for license not required, repealing provisions relating to carrying firearms on public streets or public property in Philadelphia, providing for sportsman's firearm permit, further providing for licenses and repealing provisions relating to proof of license and exception. (Representatives BERNSTINE, MALONEY, GREGORY and others) - Judiciary, June 7, 2021 7

This bill amends Chapter 61 of Title 18 to provide for "constitutional carry" of a firearm.

This bill amends the Municipal Authorities Act to allow owners of multiple properties or buildings with multiple units that are served by a single meter to request to be metered and billed as any other commercial customer on the system.

This bill bans the use of handheld cellphones while driving.

This bill designates the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43267, on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, KINSEY and others) - **Transportation, May 4, 2021 **12****

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.

This bill designates the portion of Pennsylvania Route 837, also known as Duquesne Boulevard, between Center Street in the City of Duquesne, Allegheny County, and Hoffman Boulevard in West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County, as the Clifton P. Pitts Memorial Highway.

This bill requires planting of native vegetation along state highways.

924 An Act designating a roundabout at Pennsylvania Route 34, Spring Road, Pennsylvania Route 850, Valley Road, and Pisgah State Road in Carroll Township, Perry County, as the Shane E. Troutman Memorial Roundabout. (Representatives STAMBAUGH, BURNS, CONKLIN and others) - **Transportation, June 10, 2021** **4**

This bill designates a roundabout at Pennsylvania Route 34, Spring Road, Pennsylvania Route 850, Valley Road, and Pisgah State Road in Carroll Township, Perry County, as the Shane E. Troutman Memorial Roundabout.

228 An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8556, carrying SR 1008 (Eckenrode Mill Road) over Chest Creek, located in East Carroll Township, Cambria County, as the Kenneth John Ivory Memorial Bridge. (Senator LANGERHOLC) - **Transportation, June 16, 2021** **1**

This bill designates a bridge in Cambria County as the Kenneth John Ivory Memorial Bridge.

229 An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for contributions to Veterans' Trust Fund. (Senators ROBINSON, MARTIN, BARTOLOTTA and others) - **Transportation, June 10, 2021** **4**

This bill increases contribution amounts to the Veterans Trust Fund.

This bill amends Titles 18 and Title 42 to provide for enhanced sentencing of defendants convicted of child pornography if the child victim is under 10 years of age or prepubescent and further amends Title 23 to create the Task Force on Child Pornography.

This bill amends the Workers' Compensation Act to provide employers or their insurance the right to treat a third-party settlement related to a workers' compensation claim as a credit for future medical costs.
