This bill clarifies the notice for Homestead and Farmstead property tax relief on property tax bills.

This bill expands venue for victims of human trafficking to bring civil claims.

This bill amends the County Pension Law to provide flexibility in the awarding of cost-of-living increases to county annuitants.

1149 An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in consolidated county assessment, further providing for assessment of lands divided by boundary lines. (Representatives GALLOWAY, MADDEN, SANCHEZ and others) – **Local Government, June 5, 2023** **1**

This bill amends Title 53 to clarify procedures for the assessment of lands divided by municipal boundary lines.

418 An Act amending the act of April 23, 2002 (P.L.298, No.39), known as the Main Street Act, further providing for the duration of grants. (Representatives FREEMAN, JAMES, HILL-EVANS and others) – **Local Government, June 5, 2023** **1**

This bill amends the Main Street Act to extend the duration of grants associated with the administrative costs of hiring a manager.

This bill amends Title 8 to further provide for appointments and incompatible offices.

772 An Act amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, in primary and election expenses, further providing for reporting by candidate and political committees and other persons, for late contributions and independent expenditures, for oath of compliance, perjury, disqualification from office and commercial use, for residual funds and for place of filing, providing for manner of filing and for inability to file reports or statements electronically by deadline and further providing for late filing fee and certificate of filing, for additional powers and duties of the Secretary of the Commonwealth and for reports by business entities and publication by Secretary of the Commonwealth. (Representatives BRIGGS, HILL-EVANS, N. NELSON and others) - **State Government, June 5, 2023** **1**

This bill allows for electronic filing of campaign finance reports.
