*This bill allows for increases in the Personal Needs Allowance deduction for Medical Assistance-eligible individuals living in nursing facilities.*

*This bill changes the due date on the status of agriculture education in the Commonwealth.*

*This bill provides for criminalizing illicit possession of Xylazine, with verterinary use exemptions.*

**An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in employees, providing for ballistic armor for law enforcement officers. (Representatives A. BROWN, BRENNAN, ROZZI and others) - Rules, June 28, 2023 12**

*This bill requires police to wear ballistic body armor for protection during high risk law enforcement activities and provides training.*

*This bill provides for Prevailing Wage for underground utility projects.*

**An Act amending the act of June 9, 1936 (Sp.Sess.1, P.L.13, No.4), entitled "An act imposing an emergency State tax on liquor, as herein defined, sold by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the collection and payment of such tax; and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue and the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board," further providing for emergency tax on liquors and amount of tax and collection. (Representatives BENHAM, MADDEN, SANCHEZ and others) - Rules, June 28, 2023 12**

*This bill creates a grant program to provide financial support for municipalities that are in the greatest need of additional public safety measures and violent crime reduction efforts respective of their high concentration of liquor licenses.*

*This bill would amend the Third Class City Code to update the emergency powers provisions pertaining to the length of the duration of a declared emergency by the mayor.*

*This bill expands eligibility for the Pennsylvania Distinguished Service Medal and the Pennsylvania Meritorious Service Medal.*

*This bill makes non-preferred appropriations to the Pennsylvania State University.*

*This bill removes certain communications made in the presence of the state parole agents and persons holding a police officer commission employed by the Department of Corrections from the definition of "oral communication" under the Wiretap Act and extends the Wiretap Act until 2029.*
