This bill provides for grounds for involuntary termination in juvenile matters.

This bill amends Title 50 to provide protections for minors using social media and imposing penalties.

This bill protects Pennsylvania's workers, patrons and clients from secondhand smoke by closing loopholes in the Clean Indoor Air Act.

An Act amending the act of December 14, 1992 (P.L.1116, No.145), known as the Wholesale Prescription Drug Distributors License Act, further providing for definitions, for license application and for storage, handling and recordkeeping. This bill adds virtual manufacturing to the list of distributors licensed by the Wholesale Prescription Drugs Distributor License Act.

This bill ensures continued access to the personal surplus lines insurance market and caps a service fee for policy placement services.

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

This bill amends Title 68 to require individuals and businesses to submit basic information to counties when purchasing real property within the county.

This bill establishes that first responders may collect workers' compensation for post-traumatic stress injuries sustained in the course and scope of their work.
