This bill establishes a Rural Population Revitalization Commission.

This bill restructures the board of directors for the Center for Rural Pennsylvania.

(Representatives KRAJEWSKI, KINSEY, CONKLIN and others) – **Children & Youth, March 27, 2024** **12**

This bill provides for grounds for involuntary termination in juvenile matters.

This bill amends Title 50 to provide protections for minors using social media and imposing penalties.

This bill protects Pennsylvania's workers, patrons and clients from secondhand smoke by closing loopholes in the Clean Indoor Air Act.

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

This bill imposes an annual fee of \$290 per year on certain noncommercial passenger electric vehicles and provides for the Alternative Fuels Tax on Electricity.
