## SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN & YOUTH BILL

HOUSE 285

An Act amending Titles 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in proceedings prior to petition to adopt, further providing for grounds for involuntary termination; and, in juvenile matters, further providing for disposition of dependent child. (Representatives KRAJEWSKI, KINSEY, CONKLIN and others) - Children & Youth, March 27, 2024

This bill provides for grounds for involuntary termination in juvenile matters.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILL

HOUSE 1743

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school directors, further providing for school director training programs. (Representatives MADDEN, PROBST, HILL-EVANS and others) - Education, May 8, 2024

This bill enhances and makes more efficient the training of elected school board officials.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILL

HOUSE 1958 2757

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, providing for employer child care contribution tax credit. (Representatives HANBIDGE, CEPHAS, SAMUELSON and others) – Finance, May 8, 2024

This bill provides for a tax benefit for employers who contribute to employee child care.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILLS

HOUSE

1657 2317 An Act amending the act of June 13, 2008 (P.L.182, No.27), known as the Clean Indoor Air Act, further providing for title of act, for definitions, for prohibition, for signage, for enforcement, for preemption of local ordinances and for repeal; and making editorial changes. (Representatives FRANKEL, RABB, D. WILLIAMS and others) – Health, April 17, 2024

This bill protects Pennsylvania's workers, patrons and clients from secondhand smoke by closing loopholes in the Clean Indoor Air Act.

HOUSE 2208 3014

An Act amending the act of April 17, 2016 (P.L.84, No.16), known as the Medical Marijuana Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; in medical marijuana controls, further providing for electronic tracking and for laboratory; and, in Medical Marijuana Advisory Board, further providing for advisory board. (Representatives FRANKEL, MADDEN, HILL-EVANS and others) - Health, May 8, 2024

This bill improves oversight of medical Marijuana testing labs.

SENATE

An Act establishing the Women, Infants and Children State Advisory Board. (Senators SCHWANK, BROOKS, COSTA and others) - Health, May 8, 2024

This bill establishes the Women, Infants, and Children State Advisory Board.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILL

HOUSE 2138 3055

An Act amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, in casualty insurance, providing for coverage for blood pressure monitors. (Representatives STEELE, HANBIDGE, PROBST and others) - Insurance, May 8, 2024

This bill requires health insurance policies to cover blood pressure monitors for pregnant and postpartum insureds.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 1806

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, further providing for false statements, investigations and penalty; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MAYES, D. MILLER, MADDEN and others) – Judiciary, April 17, 2024

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

### THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 1371

An Act providing for duties of certifying officials and certifying agencies regarding the processing of certification form petitions. (Representatives HOHENSTEIN, MIHALEK, BURGOS and others) - Appropriations, March 26, 2024 Fiscal-Note Attached

This bill provides certifying agencies with clarity and consistency for providing nonimmigrant victims with documentation to use when applying for a U Visa.

### THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE TRANSPORTATION BILL

SENATE **656** 1519

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in liquid fuels and fuels tax, further providing for definitions and for imposition of tax, exemptions and deductions and providing for electric vehicle road user charge; and imposing penalty. (Senators ROTHMAN, DUSH. AND WARD) - Appropriations, April 2024 **Fiscal-Note** 10, **Attached** 10

This bill imposes an annual fee of \$290 per year on certain noncommercial passenger electric vehicles and provides for the Alternative Fuels Tax on Electricity.

## THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL

HOUSE 1632 3069

An Act amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, in interpretation and definitions, further providing for definitions; and, in liability and compensation, providing for compensation for post-traumatic stress injury. (Representatives O'MARA, SOLOMON, GILLEN and others) - Appropriations, May 07, 2024 Fiscal-Note Attached 2

This bill provides compensation for post-traumatic stress injury.
