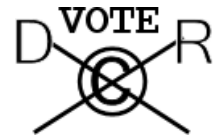

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

An Act amending Title 2 (Administrative Law and Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in practice and procedure, providing for child victims and witnesses. (Senators KEARNEY, FONTANA, TARTAGLIONE and others) - Judiciary, May 20, 2024 **3**



This bill extends the protections provided to child witnesses during civil and criminal proceedings to administrative proceedings before the Department of Human Services.
