This bill imposes enhanced notification requirements for private acquisitions of municipal water/wastewater systems.

This bill establishes the Performance -based Funding Council to develop a new performance-based funding system for Penn State, Pitt, and Temple.

This bill provides for automatic return of unclaimed property valued at \$10,000 or less and makes changes to unclaimed property process.

This bill ensures that the costs for hospital services are publicly available in accordance with federal law and provides patients information about facility fees in advance of procedures.

An Act amending the act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known as the Health Care Facilities Act, providing for health systems protection; imposing a fine; and promulgating regulations. (Representatives BOROWSKI, TAKAC, PROBST and others) - **Rules, July 01, 2024** **7**

This bill codifies existing powers of the Attorney General related to health care mergers and provides for advance notification of mergers and acquisitions.

This bill provides for violence prevention in health care facilities.

This bill provides for appropriation and audit of moneys and would require a General Assembly appropriation for expenditures from the Game Fund.
