This bill streamlines the Child Custody Determination Factors.

This bill removes the Pennsylvania State Police Enlisted Complement Cap.

This bill allows for workers' compensation benefits for serious and permanent disfigurement of the body.

This bill creates OSHA for public employees modeled after the federal version.

This bill amends the Second Class Township Code to all such township to adopt ordinances with immediate effective dates.

This bill provides a 15-24.5% cost-of-living adjustment based on the date of retirement to eligible Public School Employees' Retirement System & State Employees' Retirement System pre-Act 9 retirees.
