A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- Disapproving the Environmental Quality Board regulations on a CO2 Budget Trading Program.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Environmental Quality Board proposed at 50 Pa.B.
- 4 6212 (November 7, 2020) regulations on a CO2 Budget Trading
- 5 Program in accordance with sections 5(a)(1) and (8) and 6.3 of
- 6 the act of January 8, 1960 (1959 P.L.2119, No.787), known as the
- 7 Air Pollution Control Act; and
- 8 WHEREAS, On July 13, 2021, the Environmental Quality Board
- 9 approved "CO2 Budget Trading Program" Regulations (Environmental
- 10 Quality Board Regulation #7-559 and Independent Regulatory
- 11 Review Commission #3274) (regulations); and
- 12 WHEREAS, On August 18, 2021, the Environmental Resources and
- 13 Energy Committee of the Senate, in accordance with section
- 14 5.1(j.2) of the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as
- 15 the Regulatory Review Act, voted to disapprove the regulations;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, On September 1, 2021, notwithstanding the

- 1 disapproval of the Senate Oversight Committee, the Independent
- 2 Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC) voted to approve the
- 3 regulations; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In a letter dated September 1, 2021, the IRRC
- 5 notified the Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of the
- 6 Senate that the IRRC adopted an order approving the regulations;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of
- 9 the Senate has determined that the submitted regulations should
- 10 be disapproved by the General Assembly; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of
- 12 the Senate is reporting this resolution under section 7(d) of
- 13 the Regulatory Review Act for action by the Senate, which shall
- 14 have 30 calendar days or 10 legislative days, whichever is
- 15 longer, from the date on which the concurrent resolution has
- 16 been reported to adopt the concurrent resolution; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives shall have 30 calendar
- 18 days or 10 legislative days, whichever is longer, from the date
- 19 on which the concurrent resolution has been adopted by the
- 20 Senate to adopt the concurrent resolution; therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
- 22 General Assembly disapprove the Environmental Quality Board
- 23 regulations on a CO2 Budget Trading Program; and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with section 7(d) of the
- 25 Regulatory Review Act, this resolution constitute a bar to
- 26 promulgation of the regulations.
