### OVERVIEW:

House Bill 73 amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) further providing for exemptions from jury duty. Under this legislation, persons 70 years of age or older may opt not to serve and would be exempt from jury duty.

This act takes effect in 60 days.

### ANALYSIS:

According to the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, exempting jurors aged 70 or older would result in stable costs since exempted jurors would be replaced by younger jurors.

The enactment of House Bill 73 will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
