OVERVIEW:

House Bill 74 would prohibit state liquor stores from accepting cards issued by the Department of Public Welfare for public assistance as payment for alcoholic beverages or gift cards to be used for alcoholic beverages. In addition, this bill would allow the Liquor Control Board to issue a special occasion permit to a non-profit organization that supports mushrooms and is located in a third class county. Finally, this bill would allow the holder of a sacramental wine license to sell food on the premises.

This legislation shall take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The provisions of this bill would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or local government funds.
