OVERVIEW:

House Bill 106 amends the First Class City Government Law by repealing a section (53 P.S. §12235) that sets penalties for impersonating a police officer. The language being repealed dates from 1901 and is in conflict with §4912 of Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses), relating to impersonating a public servant.

This act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The enactment of House Bill 106 will not have an adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
