OVERVIEW:

House Bill 107 repeals Act 326 of 1915, which provides a penalty for unauthorized persons in a city of the first class from possessing or wearing a police badge. The act being repealed is in conflict with §4912 of Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses).

This act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The enactment of House Bill 107 will not have an adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
