OVERVIEW:

House Bill 127 amends the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act to provide for licensure of genetic counselors by the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

The bill will take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The Department of State estimates that the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine would be responsible for licensing 30 trained genetic counselors in the Commonwealth under the provisions of this bill. Licensure would require additional personnel and operating costs to start up, which is estimated by the Department to be approximately \$1,600 per year. However, the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine is self-funded and all costs will be covered by licensure fees, which are expected to be around \$53 per license on an annual basis. No additional costs to the General Fund will be incurred by this bill.
