**OVERVIEW:**

House Bill 320 amends Title 30 (Fish) repealing provisions granting Fish and Boat commissioners the powers of waterways patrolmen.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:**

Fish and Boat Commissioners are currently given a badge and the same powers as a waterways conservation officer without training, thus leading to potential liability issues.

Adoption of this legislation should have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
