OVERVIEW:

House Bill 339 amends the Workforce Development Act of 2001. Under the act, members of the Pennsylvania National Guard and the Reserve Component of the United States Armed Forces would be given preference for placement in any program falling under the act, for one year after serving in active duty. This preference would also apply to spouses. Both members and their spouses would need to provide documentation of active duty and must meet the requirements of the program.

This act would take effect 60 days after passage.

ANALYSIS:

Persons affected by the act will be given preference in programs currently established and funded under the Workforce Development Act. No additional funds are necessary to carry out the provisions of House Bill 838.
