OVERVIEW:

House Bill 528 provides for registration of pharmacy technicians and pharmacy technician trainees. It lists the qualifications for pharmacy technicians and pharmacy technician trainees and lists the activities the pharmacy technician and pharmacy technician trainees may and may not perform.

The act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The bill amends the Pharmacy Act to require the State Board of Pharmacy to register pharmacy technicians and pharmacy technician trainees. The Board must promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this Act, including the determination of a fee for applying for registration and renewal. According to the Department of State, any cost that is associated with the registration of pharmacy technicians and pharmacy technician trainees will be offset by the registration and renewal fees.
