OVERVIEW:

House Bill 726 amends Act 153 of 2004 which established the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System by providing for the Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) to establish and maintain the Missing Endangered Person Advisory System (MEPAs) to assist in the recovery of missing persons who are at special risk of harm or injury.

Under this bill, the PSP shall establish such protocols necessary for the effective operation of each system.

This act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

This fiscal note assumes that the enactment of House Bill 726 will occur after FY 2009/10 and would therefore have no costs in the current year.

According to PSP, they anticipate the fiscal impact of this bill to be about \$60,000 as result of overtime and call-outs by troopers.
