OVERVIEW:

House Bill 810, Printer's Number 900 amends the Volunteer Firefighter' Relief Association Act to permit relief funds to be used to pay for emergency medical service training.

ANALYSIS:

The act currently specifies several purposes for which relief associations may use their funds. The addition of expenses for bona fide emergency medical technician or paramedic training school will not have any fiscal impact upon the commonwealth.
