### OVERVIEW:

House Bill 929, as amended by A01923, amends the Public School Code of 1949 to allow a school board of directors to establish a program for granting a high school diploma to any honorably discharged veteran who served in the Vietnam War between February 26, 1961 and May 7, 1975 and who, except for entry into military service, would have graduated between 1962 and 1975. The school board of directors is also authorized to award a posthumous diploma to any eligible veteran who meets the same criteria.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

### ANALYSIS:

Enactment of this bill will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
