OVERVIEW:

House Bill 975 provides for geologist-in-training certification and replaces the existing professional engineer, land surveyor and geologist continuing education provisions with language that is based on National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) model continuing education language.

The act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The bill states that the State Registration Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors and Geologists shall not require courses to be preapproved, but may preapproved course providers. The board shall have final authority regarding approval of courses and professional development hour credit determination. The licensee shall be responsible for maintaining records to be used to support credits claimed. Passage of this bill would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
