OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1280, as amended by A07005, directs the Bureau of Emergency Medical Services in the Department of Health (DOH), in cooperation with Pennsylvania Emergency Health Services Council, to establish an emergency services memorial flag. The bill specifies that the DOH shall maintain the official flag, implement the provisions of the act, and oversee the production, acquisition and distribution of the flag.

The act shall take effect 60 days after passage.

ANALYSIS:

The Department of Health anticipates minimal costs associated with this act. The department can absorb any additional costs within their current operating budget.
