OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1303, as amended by A05462, would require the Department of Labor and Industry and the Department of Health to make available information on the Departments' websites concerning breastfeeding, including information about expressing breast milk in the workplace.

The bill will take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The Department of Labor and Industry and the Department of Health are both required to place information on their respective websites regarding breastfeeding. The information must specifically address breastfeeding in the workplace. The Department of Health will also develop written materials concerning breastfeeding for distribution to women of childbearing age. Both departments have indicated that the informational activities required by the bill as amended can be carried out within existing resources.
