OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1330 amends Title 3 (Agriculture) by adding the definitions of certified parking meter inspector and local government unit. Also, it provides for the transfer of the State weights and measures inspection requirements for parking meters to the local government units who utilize and are currently responsible for maintaining the meters.

The legislation takes effect 90 days from enactment.

ANALYSIS:

The proposed legislation has no Commonwealth costs or savings. Local authorities are currently for the maintenance of their meters. The legislation will allow them to do the weights and measures certification when they are maintaining. The local government unit or authority may accept reports from Certified Parking Meter Inspectors to meet the inspection and testing requirements. The Department of Agriculture will still be responsible for issuing regulations relative to this proposal for allowing local weights and measure certification.
