OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1420 appropriates \$27,733,000 from the State Employees' Retirement Fund.

The bill takes effect either July 1, 2009 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

The bill makes an appropriation from the SER Fund to provide for the expenses incurred by the State Employees' Retirement Board for the administration of the system for the fiscal year July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
