OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1421 appropriates \$45,755,000 from five restricted revenue accounts in the General Fund to the Department of State for use by the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs in support of the professional licensure boards and the State Athletic Commission.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

The bill makes 2009/10 appropriations as recommended by the Governor for the general operations of the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs, State Board of Medicine, State Board of Osteopathic Medicine, State Board of Podiatry, and the State Athletic Commission.
