OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1426 amends Act 274 of 1978 (establishing the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency) by allowing a member of the General Assembly, who sits on the commission, to delegate an employee of the Commonwealth to represent the member. This delegate may lawfully vote and otherwise act on behalf of the member.

This act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

The enactment of House Bill 1426 would not have an adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
